Civil Aviation Directive:
Design, Operations and Certification of Aerodromes

GENERAL

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017, Part 23, empowers the Authority to issue civil aviation directives on the matters which are prescribed by regulations.

DIRECTIVE

It is hereby directed that the requirements for the design, operations and certification of aerodromes are those laid down in the Manual of Aerodrome Standards, as amended.

PURPOSE

Document CAD-ADR/61(1) contains the technical standards, rules, requirements, methods, specifications, characteristics and procedures which are applicable in respect of *Design, Operations and Certification of Aerodromes*.

COMMENCEMENT

This Directive shall come into force on 01st July 2019.

APPLICABILITY

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017, Part 13, Regulation 61.

EXCEPTIONS

Nil

INCORPORATION OF INTERNATIONAL AVIATION STANDARDS

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017 Regulation 110, empowers the Authority to prescribe conditions and technical standards relating to any national or international aviation standard.

REVOCATION

CAD-ADR/68(1) is hereby revoked and replaced with this CAD; CAD-ADR/61(1).

The Manual of Aerodrome Standards, as amended, is incorporated into the technical standards contained in this document.
