This Airside Notice serves to inform all airport users of the coming into force of the ‘**Seychelles Civil Aviation Authority (Aerodrome) Orders 2010**’ as signed by Mr Gilbert Faure, Chief Executive Officer, SCAA on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2009.
