



## APPLICATION TO CARRY MUNITIONS OF WAR AND/OR CLASS 1 DANGEROUS GOODS

1. *This form applies to (a) all requests to carry munitions of war and (b) only those requests to carry Class 1 dangerous goods where they do not comply with the normal requirements of the Technical Instructions. Parts 1 and 2 must be completed in all instances. Part 3 must be completed for all munitions of war. Part 4 must be completed for Class 1 dangerous goods that require an exemption or additional approval in order to be carried. If there is insufficient space to list all items, they can be listed on a separate sheet.*
2. *Reserve*
3. *Application for permission should be made at least 10 working days before the date of the flight on which the dangerous goods are to be carried. Applications should be sent to SCAA, Safety Regulation, Flight Operations Inspectorate, Pointe Larue, Mahe, Seychelles, Tel no: 0248 384181; Fax no: 0248 384033.*
4. *Approval granted from all states (departure of all states being overflown and destination) should be attach.*
