



REFURBISHMENT WORKS AT THE INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER CONCOURSE

Subject : Replacement of International Terminal ceiling and new flooring

Introduction

In line with SCAA's continued efforts to improve the international terminal facilities, refurbishment works will be carried out at the International Passenger Concourse. The works will entail the replacement of existing false ceiling and addition of new false ceiling to cover other areas without any existing ceiling structure. Additionally, new floor tiles will be placed.

Towards the final stages of the project, a number of ceiling fans are to be installed.

The works will be implemented in phases in order to minimise disruption to airport operations.

Activities commencing Monday 04th October 2021.

- Project is to start on Monday 04th October 2021 and expected to be completed end of July 2022. Hours of work will normally be from 0730 to 1730 LT, Mondays to Saturdays and on Sundays from 0730 to 1200LT. Specific works (such as shifting of hoardings; exceptionally noisy works; working at areas than cannot be hoarded off; etc...), may be carried out from late evenings to early mornings on specific days during very low peak (or closure) hours.
- The project has been designed in 18 phases to minimize disruptions as best possible.
- The project will cover the entire International departure and arrival concourses from the: check-in desks, departure lounge entrance doors and arrival exit doors on the one side, to the: passenger drop off / pick up area on the other side. The start-up location of the works will be near the Qatar Airways Airport Office and proceed in planned phases across the passenger concourse to the car hire kiosk/airline offices location.
- A private contractor will be hoarding off areas to carry out planned works within.
- In order to maintain sufficient level of operational capability on each operating day, some phases will be undertaken in the open (i.e. not within hoarded off areas). These works will be carried out from late evenings to early mornings on specific days during very low peak (or closure) hours.
- It is expected for some noisy works to be heard during this project and all safety precautions will be carried out.
- During this project, SCAA will work with key partners to ensure best passenger flows between international and domestic terminals and for international check-in procedures.
- Subsequent project notices will be circulated as the works progresses from one phase to another.
- We count on the co-operation of all airport users during this project and to follow any instructions from SCAA officers on the terminal.
