Introduction

In line with SCAA's continued effort to upkeep existing building infrastructure, replacement of box gutters will be carried out in several Airside and Landside areas of the terminal building.

The replacement work will entail replacing damaged box gutters and the damaged eaves ceiling at roof level of the Terminal Building on both Airside and Landside areas.

The project will be undertaken by an external contractor.

Timeline of proposed works

To commence on Wednesday 01st June 2022 and be completed on Sunday 31st July 2022.

Hours of work: 0700 to 1700 LT (Mondays to Sundays), subjected to movements of flights.

General Scope of works

- I. Positioning of scaffolding at various locations of the terminal building (Airside & Landside).
- II. Removing damaged box gutters and ceiling areas.
- III. Installation of new box gutters and replacement of ceiling areas.
- IV. Necessary painting.
- V. Removal of scaffolding.

Supervision of works

The SCAA Maintenance Unit will be responsible for escorting workers and transports via approved access points/gates and conducting briefings with Airside & Terminal officers before commencement of any works.
