NOTES TO BE READ WHEN COMPLETING THIS APPLICATION FORM

1. A Certificate of Airworthiness for Export can only be issued to an aircraft that is currently registered in the Seychelles.
2. The application should be made at least four weeks prior to the date required for export.
3. An importing state may specify additional requirements to those that apply in Seychelles. When these additional requirements cannot be satisfied prior to export, the applicant must provide to the SCAA a written acceptance of the non-compliance from the Regulatory Authority of the importing state.
4. Where a survey for the issue of a Certificate of Airworthiness for Export is carried out overseas, the applicant must include a letter stating that they accept all additional costs. These costs include overseas travel, subsistence and accommodation.
5. The Airworthiness Notice No.18 provides further information on the procedures associated with the Certificate of Airworthiness for Export.
6. The completed application form is to be sent to the Seychelles Civil Aviation Authority, Finance Division, P.O. Box 181, Victoria, Mahé, Seychelles and must be accompanied by the appropriate charge in accordance with the Air Navigation Fees Regulations.
