Civil Aviation Directive:
Aircraft Crew and Licensing

GENERAL

Civil Aviation (Civil Aviation Directives) Regulations, 2005 empowers the Authority to issue civil aviation directives on the matters which are prescribed by regulations.

PURPOSE

Document SCAA CAD-PEL/106_1 contains the technical standards, rules, requirements, methods, specifications, characteristics and procedures which are applicable in respect of Authority Requirements Aircrew.

APPLICABILITY

Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order Part 4.

INCORPORATION OF INTERNATIONAL AVIATION STANDARDS

Civil Aviation (Civil Aviation Directives) Regulations, 2005 empowers the Authority to incorporate by reference into a directive, any international aviation standard.

The international aviation standard known as "**European Aviation Safety Agency, Part ARA**" (as at the original issue date, 3rd November 2011), as applicable to authority requirements aircrew, is incorporated into the technical standards contained in this document, as amended.

DIRECTIVE

It is hereby directed that authority requirements aircrew shall conform to the technical standards of EASA Part ARA inclusive of all associated Appendices, AMC and GM (as defined by the EASA) except as provided for below.

COMMENCEMENT

This Directive shall come into force on 18th August 2014.
