Civil Aviation Directive:
Aircraft Crew and Licensing

GENERAL

Civil Aviation (Civil Aviation Directives) Regulations, 2005 empowers the Authority to issue civil aviation directives on the matters which are prescribed by regulations.

PURPOSE

Document SCAA CAD-PEL/20_1 contains the technical standards, rules, requirements, methods, specifications, characteristics and procedures which are applicable in respect of Aircraft Crew and Licensing.

APPLICABILITY

Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order Part 4, 20.

INCORPORATION OF INTERNATIONAL AVIATION STANDARDS

Civil Aviation (Civil Aviation Directives) Regulations, 2005 empowers the Authority to incorporate by reference into a directive, any international aviation standard.

The international aviation standard known as "Joint Aviation Authority, JAR FCL Part 4 (at Amendment 3, dated 1st September 2005) ", as applicable to *Flight Crew Licensing (Flight Engineer)*, is incorporated into the technical standards contained in this document, as amended.

DIRECTIVE

It is hereby directed that medical standards relating to flight crew licensing shall conform to the technical standards of JAR FCL Part 4 inclusive of all associated Appendices, AMC, ACJ, AGM, TGL and IEM (as defined by the JAA) except as provided for below.

COMMENCEMENT

This Directive shall come into force on 1st January 2006.
