SUBJECT:	Trials with new floodlights	

1. The SCAA will in the near future be undertaking a project to replace the present main apron flood lights with a new system.
2. In view of the above, the Engineering Division of the SCAA has started trials with the new lights so as to identify any shortcomings or hazards at an early stage of the development of the project. Three of the new lights have been installed temporarily on Flood Tower B and therefore covering the areas from Bay 5 to 6. There will be some spilling over on Bay 3. The old system is still in place and can be switched on instead of the trial lights at any time. Since the trial lights do not cover Bay 3, whenever aircraft is parked on Bay 3, the old system will need to be switched on.
3. The SCAA is calling for feedbacks on the performance of the lights as well as any other comments you may have. Grateful if you could invite your pilots, airside drivers and other ramp users to send their comments to cmondon@scaa.sc and cc to nconfait@scaa.sc.
