

REFURBISHMENT WORKS AT THE INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER CONCOURSE

PROJECT NOTICE UPDATE (No.: 3)

Subject : Replacement of International Terminal Concourse Ceiling and New Flooring

Update No. 3

Installation of the new ceiling and floor tiles within the hoarded off area adjacent to the Turkish Airline office and opposite the banking complex will be completed on Monday 17th January 2022.

The next phase of works is scheduled as follows;

- Contractor will commence works to shift hoarding adjacent to the banking complex and extending towards the zebra crossing of the international terminal after the departure of Emirates Airline 708 to Dubai on the evening of Monday 17th January 2022.
- The hoarding may take several days to be completed and is expected to be in place for 6 weeks. This particular work will be done every night of the week until completed.
- Upon completion of the new hoarding, directional signages will be affixed as required to guide and advise passengers and airport users.
- Once all the hoardings are erected, works will then commence within to install a new ceiling, a new airport customer service desk and then a new tiled flooring.
- Furthermore, to this updated project notice is a separate document of the intended new hoarding plan (demarked as purple), adjacent to the banking complex and towards the zebra crossing.
- The 2 vending machines and the MCB ATM will be relocated behind the Turkish Airline office.

Noisy works and some dust may be generated throughout this project and all measures will be undertaken to reduce the inconveniences to all airport users.

Congestion for banking services may pursue during this phase of the project.
