

REFURBISHMENT WORKS AT THE INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER CONCOURSE

PROJECT NOTICE UPDATE (No.: 4)

Subject : Replacement of International Terminal Concourse Ceiling and New Flooring

Update No. 4

Installation of the new ceiling, floor tiles and construction of a new airport customer service desk within the hoarded area off adjacent to the banking complex and zebra crossing of the international terminal will be completed on Monday 14th March 2022.

The next phase of works is scheduled as follows;

- Contractor will commence works to shift hoarding to area in front of the main doors used for entry into the international departure lounge, existing airport customer service desk and the first two international check-in counters after the departure of Emirates Airline 708 to Dubai on the evening of Monday 14th March 2022.
- Alternate entrance into the international departure lounge is already demarked.
- The hoarding may take several days to be completed and is expected to be in place for 5 weeks. This particular work will be done every night of the week until completed.
- Upon completion of the new hoarding, directional signages will be affixed as required to guide and advise passengers and airport users.
- Once the hoarding has been erected, works will then commence within to demolish the existing airport customer service desk, install a new ceiling and then a new tiled flooring.
- Furthermore, to this updated project notice is a separate document of the intended new hoarding plan (demarked as purple).
- The first two international check-in counters will be closed due to the very limited movement area and caution must be exercised during such construction works.

Noisy works and some dust may be generated throughout this project and all measures will be undertaken to reduce the inconveniences to all airport users.
