

REFURBISHMENT WORKS AT THE INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER CONCOURSE

PROJECT NOTICE UPDATE (No.: 5)

Subject : Replacement of International Terminal Concourse Ceiling and New Flooring

Update No. 5

Installation of the new ceiling and floor tiles within the hoarded area off opposite the new airport information desk of the international terminal will be completed on Monday 18th April 2022.

The next phase of works is scheduled as follows;

- Contractor will commence works to shift hoarding to area adjacent to the new airport information desk and zebra crossing and extend along the half wall to where the public waiting area is. It will be conducted after the departure of Emirates Airline 708 to Dubai on the evening of Monday 18th April 2022.
- All the telecommunications services will be relocated outside of the hoarding, on the concourse area and nearer to the public waiting area.
- The hoarding may take several days to be completed and is expected to be in place for 9 weeks. This particular work will be done every night of the week until completed.
- Upon completion of the new hoarding, directional signages will be affixed as required to guide and advise passengers and airport users.
- Once the hoarding has been erected, works will then commence within to install a new ceiling and then a new tiled flooring.
- Furthermore, to this updated project notice is a separate document of the intended new hoarding plan (demarked as purple).
- There will be limited area for arriving passengers to flow between the hoarding and international queuing lanes towards central locations of the terminal and onwards to the domestic terminal. It is recommended during peak operations at the airport with both arrivals and departures is for arriving passengers to be guided externally of the public waiting area and then rejoin the terminal concourse area at the zebra crossing location.

Noisy works and some dust may be generated throughout this project phase and all measures will be undertaken to reduce the inconveniences to all airport users.
